## The type of personal information we collect

We currently collect and process the following information:

- Identity data: Including Name, title, date of birth, gender, marital status, driving license (copy), passport (copy) and utility bill (copy).
- Contact information: Including Residential address, trading address, telephone numbers, email address.
- Financial Data: Including Bank details (account number, overdraft facility, copy of bank statements), accounts (audited and unaudited), overdraft facility, source of income.
- Marketing and communication: This is your marketing preferences from us and our third parties.

# How we get the personal information and why we have it

Most of the personal information we process is provided to us directly by you through contacting us to apply for our services.

We also receive personal information indirectly, from the following sources in the following scenarios:

- Introducers and other businesses where we have a trading relationship.
- Credit Reference Agencies (CRA).

We use the information that you have given us to:

- Apply for financial products.
- Improve our products and services.
- Send promotional emails, special offers or other information which we think you may find interesting using the address you have provided.
- Conduct market research. We may contact you via phone, email, or mail. We may use your feedback to customise the website.
- Meet our legal obligations, such as validating your identity and prevent illegal activities, such as money laundering and fraud.

We may share this information with third parties. To approve your application our funders will supply your personal information to credit reference agencies and the Credit Reference Agencies (CRAs) will give the funders information about you, such as your financial history. The funders do this to assess credit worthiness, product suitability, check your identity, manage your account, trace and recover debts and prevent criminal activity.

The funders will continue to exchange information with the CRAs on an ongoing basis, including about your settled accounts and any debts not fully repaid on time. CRAs will share your information with other organisations. Your data will also be linked to the data of your spouse, any joint applicants, or other financial associates.

The personal information you have supplied will also be shared with fraud prevention agencies who will use it to prevent fraud and money-laundering and verify your identity. If fraud is detected, you could be refused certain services, finance, or employment.

#### How we store your personal information

We are committed to ensuring that your information is secure. All information you provide to us is stored on our secure servers.

We only retain your personal information for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes we collected it for, including for the purposes of satisfying any legal and regulatory obligations.

Should your application be refused, or you decide not to proceed with the application we may still retain your information for as long as necessary to satisfy any legal and regulatory obligations. ### **International Transfers**

Under data protection law, you have rights including:

Your right of access - You have the right to ask us for copies of your personal information.

Your right to rectification - You have the right to ask us to rectify personal information you think is inaccurate. You also have the right to ask us to complete information you think is incomplete.

Your right to erasure - You have the right to ask us to erase your personal information in certain circumstances. Your right to restriction of processing - You have the right to ask us to restrict the processing of your personal information in certain circumstances.
